

Parental Responsibility

Under the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), which came into effect from September 2008 and revised in September 2012, I am legally required to establish who has Parental Responsibility of every child in my care.

What is Parental Responsibility?:

A married couple who have children together both automatically have parental responsibility. Parental responsibility continues after divorce. Mothers automatically have parental responsibility.

Where the parents are not married the father has parental responsibility if:

His name is registered on birth certificate (after 1 December 2003).

He later marries the mother.

Both parents have signed an authorised Parental Responsibility Agreement.

He obtains a Parental Responsibility Order from the court.

He obtains a Residence Order from the court

He becomes the child's guardian.
